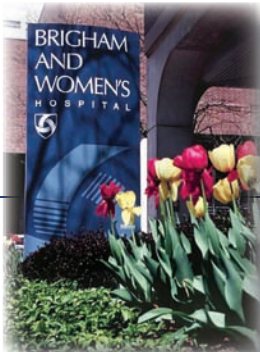
Introduction
