Whether you're International or not, filing your taxes can be challenging. Information

is available for all postdocs.

- The [National Postdoc Association's Tax Information Page](#) explains withholding, filing, fellowships, FICA, and more.
- The PIO's annual [International Tax Expert Presentations](#) explains that all non-immigrant visa holders (H-1B, J-1, F-1, O-1 and TN) must file a U.S. Income Tax Return even if they did not earn income from a US source.
