Washington University in Saint Louis, in conjunction with the University of Missouri, the Center for Emerging Technologies, and Innovate Saint Louis, is now offering positions in one of the nation's top research environments.

This is our second year of funding from the National Science Foundation for the Innovation Acceleration Partnership (IAP) Fellowships. We seek individuals with an advanced degree (Ph.D. or equivalent) in the biomedical engineering, life sciences, nanotechnology, or medical fields, who have an interest in expanding their understanding of technology transfer and commercialization, or individuals with MBA or JD degrees who have strong academic or practical science credentials.
