Dr. Stacey Clardy is clinical and research faculty in the Division of Neuroimmunology and Autoimmune Neurology at the University of Utah and a Neurologist at the George E. Wahlen Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center. She is the Founder/Director of the autoimmune neurology clinic and the autoimmune neurology fellowship program at the University of Utah and Principal Investigator of the ExTINGUISH Trial— a prospective, international, randomized clinical trial for NMDA receptor encephalitis that Vanderbilt is participating in; currently enrolling at 37 sites in the US and 2 in Europe.
