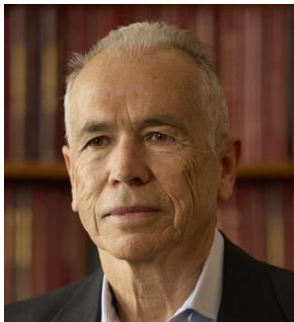

**Dr. Ascherio** graduated in medicine at the University of Milan in 1978. After practicing medicine and public health in Latin America and Africa for several years, he moved to Boston, where he received a doctoral degree in epidemiology and population sciences in 1992, and he is now Professor of Epidemiology and Nutrition at the Harvard TH Chan School of Public Health and Professor of Medicine at the Harvard Medical School. He has contributed to numerous discoveries on risk factors for Parkinson disease, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, and multiple sclerosis (MS). Most recently, he has been recognized for providing definitive evidence that infection with the Epstein-Barr virus is the leading cause of MS. He is the recipient of numerous awards, including honorary doctoral degrees from the University of Southern Denmark and the University of Bergen, the 2023 Falch Lecture Prize, and the 2025 Breakthrough Prize.
