

BRIGHAM UROGYNECOLOGY GROUP POST-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS AFTER CYSTOSCOPIC EXAM

This is a guide for use following your procedure.

For the next 24-48 hours:

- 1. It is important to increase the amount of liquids you drink. Try to drink 48-64 fluid ounces per day unless you are limiting fluids for other medical reasons. Water is the best choice.
- 2. It is important to try to completely empty your bladder each time you urinate. We recommend sitting down, relaxing, and bending forward for 1-2 seconds after you initially empty. Be patient, and do not rush in and out of the bathroom.
- 3. It is common for your urine to be pink in color and/or for you to see small flecks of blood. These symptoms should resolve in 1-2 days.
- 4. Slight discomfort (burning with urination) can sometimes occur. Acetaminophen (Tylenol) 325 mg, one to two tablets every 6 hours, or Ibuprofen (e.g. Advil) 200 mg, one to two tablets every 6 hours, should relieve the pain.
- 5. A prescription for an antibiotic may be given to you. It is important that you take this medicine as directed by your urogynecologist to prevent any infections.

WHEN TO CALL

- Bright red bleeding with urination
- Chills or fever above 100.4°F or 38°C
- Inability to urinate
- Pain not relieved by Acetaminophen or Ibuprofen
- Any other symptom that worries you
