Parking at Brigham and Women's Hospital, Main Campus

Paid Self-parking is available at [45 Francis Street](#), [80 Francis Street ServiCenter Garage](#) and [60 Fenwood Road Garage](#).

- Self-parking can be validated on the first floor of 75 Francis Street, near the information desk

Paid Valet parking is available at a reduced rate for patient use only:

- 24 hours per day, 7 days per week at [75 Francis Street](#).
- Monday through Friday 6am-6pm at [60 Fenwood Road](#), [15 Francis Street](#), & [45 Francis Street](#).

Public Transit Options

T The following public transportation options exist, distances are calculated from closest stop to 75 Francis Street
Scan QR code for MBTA schedules

Bus Routes:

- **MBTA Bus 39** drops on Huntington Ave (0.1 miles)
- **MBTA Bus 66** drops on Tremont Street (0.1 miles)
- **MBTA Busses 60,65, CT2** drops on Brookline Avenue (0.2 miles)

Train Options

- **Green Line Branch D – Brookline Village Stop** on Station St (has access to MGB Shuttle service, see above) (0.7 miles)
- **Green Line Branch E – Brigham Circle Stop** on Huntington Ave & Francis St (0.1 miles)
- **Orange Line** – Roxbury Crossing (0.6 miles)
- **Commuter Rail** – Ruggles (0.9 miles)



The RIDE by the MBTA

THE RIDE paratransit service provides door-to-door, shared-ride transportation to eligible people who cannot use fixed-route transit (bus, subway, trolley) all or some of the time because of a physical, cognitive, or mental disability. The RIDE is available for a fee in and around the Boston community.
